RESOLUTION OF THE ACME TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTION #R-2019- 15 Resolution on agreement for Metro Open issues Acme Special Board Meeting April 11, 2019

At a Special Board meeting of the Acme Township Board of Trustees, held on April 11, 2019, the Acme Township Board of Trustees, on a motion made by Nelson and seconded by Jenema passed the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Townships of Acme, East Bay, and Garfield have, through negotiations, agreed to revise the Metro Emergency Services Authority Articles of Incorporation;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Articles of Incorporation, the Acme, East Bay, and Garfield Township Board must approve revisions to the Articles of Incorporation; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution indicates the Townships' agreement to revise the Articles of Incorporation as set out below.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Acme Township agrees to the following revisions to the Articles of Incorporation:
 - a. Election of Metro Board Officers shall require a majority vote including an affirmative vote from one board member from each township.
 - b. All Metro Board policies (not operational policies), contracts exceeding 1% of approved budget, and lease terms shall require a majority vote including an affirmative vote from one board member from each township.
 - c. Regarding Budgets:
 - i. Any item expenditure over 1% of the approved budget, but <u>not</u> in the approved budget, shall require a majority vote including an affirmative vote from one board member from each township.
 - ii. Any dollars greater than 1% of the approved budget that move from one cost center to another shall require a majority vote including an affirmative vote from one board member from each township.
- Upon resolution by each Township demonstrating agreement to above revisions, Metro Emergency Services Authority general council will prepare a formal amendment to the Articles for each Township's adoption.
