Zoning Ordinance Amendment 010 - An Ordinance to amend the Acme Township Zoning Ordinance ("Zoning Ordinance") for the purpose imposing a temporary moratorium on applications for Computing and Data Processing Centers.

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Zoning Ordinance and place a temporary halt on the review and approval of new Computing and Data Processing uses, including those large-scale uses that are commonly referred to as data centers, in Acme Township until the impacts of this kind of development on Acme Township can be examined, and comprehensive Zoning Ordinance amendments can be made if necessary to protect the best interests of the community.

All interested persons are invited to attend and be heard at the public hearings before the Planning Commission. After the public hearings the Planning Commission may or may not deliberate and make its recommendation based on the Acme Township Zoning Ordinance to the Township Board, which will subsequently take appropriate action on the amendment. The proposed amendment may be inspected at the Acme Township Hall between 7:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. ZONING ORDINANCE TEXT AMENDMENT

An Ordinance to amend the Acme Township Zoning Ordinance (“Zoning Ordinance”) for the purpose imposing a temporary moratorium on applications for Computing and Data Processing Centers.

ACME TOWNSHIP HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1 Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Zoning Ordinance and place a temporary halt on the review and approval of new Computing and Data Processing uses, including those large-scale uses that are commonly referred to as data centers, in Acme Township until the impacts of this kind of development on Acme Township can be examined, and comprehensive Zoning Ordinance amendments can be made if necessary to protect the best interests of the community.

Section 2 Moratorium: As of the effective date of this ordinance, and notwithstanding any other provisions in the Zoning Ordinance, no applications for Computing and Data Processing uses, including applications for planned developments, special use permits, site plans, or land use permits will be processed by Acme Township, nor will any approvals or zoning permits be granted for Computing and Data Processing Uses.

Section 3 Expiration of the Moratorium: The provisions of this ordinance are temporary in nature and are intended to be replaced by subsequent legislative enactment of future Zoning Ordinance amendments concerning Computing and Data Processing uses. With or without subsequent legislative enactment, the prohibitions in Section 2 of this ordinance will expire automatically six months from the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4: If any section, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be declared to be unconstitutional, void, illegal, or ineffective by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such section, clause, or provision so declared shall thereby cease to be part of this ordinance, but the remainder of this ordinance shall stand and be in full force and effect.

Section 5: The effective date of this ordinance shall be the 8th day after publication.
