

HOW DO I GET A BALLOT IF I'M IN THE MILITARY OR IF I'M AN OVERSEAS CIVILIAN?

Military and overseas civilian voters can receive a ballot by e-mail, fax, or mail by submitting an application with the clerk. (The voted ballot must be returned by mail for security purposes). One application is valid for every election in their jurisdiction in that calendar year. When submitting your request, be sure to indicate whether you would like to receive your ballot by email, fax, or mail.
